


FLOOD INFORMATION DEBRIS REMOVAL GUIDELINES



Additional guidelines on debris separation:

- <u>Electronics</u> also may include mercury devices and fluorescent lighting equipment such as thermostats, mercury switches, fluorescent fixtures and bulbs, light ballasts and similar materials.
 - Package fluorescent bulbs carefully to avoid breaking.
- <u>Large appliances</u> also may include metal yard equipment, mowers, lawn furniture, metal bed frames, ducting, furnaces, pipes, metal toys, pots and pans, and other metal items.
 - Remove food from appliances, seal food in plastic bags, and place in household garbage pile.
 - Remove or secure doors to keep children out of large appliances.
- <u>Hazardous waste</u> also may include medication, aerosol cans, oven cleaners, degreasers, toilet cleaners, furniture polish, batteries, automotive fluids (new and used), drain cleaners, mercury thermometers, rat poison, flea powder, insecticides, weed killers, fertilizers, solvents, spot removers, paint, paint thinners, lacquer, propane tanks, fuel oil, flammable liquids and bagged and labeled asbestoscontaining material removed by homeowners (not by contractors or facilities).
 - Label containers in large bold print (include product name) and do not mix materials.
